# **2013 Annual Statistical Summary**

This agency handled 34,450 calls-for-service between January 1, 2013, and December 31, 2013.

The annual summary regarding the **Police Department** activities for the **Year 2013** is as follows:

#### **Uniformed Patrol Division**

The **Uniformed Patrol Division** activities for the **Year 2013** are as follows:

#### **Summary of Traffic Summonses**

**2,412** Summonses & **1,310** Written Warnings from **5,084** Motor Vehicle Stops.

- 122 DWI Arrests
- 214 Suspended License Summonses
- 119 Reckless Driving Summonses
- 72 Uninsured Vehicle Summonses

#### **Traffic Accidents**

820 Motor Vehicle Accidents Reported

- 156 with reported injuries
- 1 fatality

#### **Drug Arrests by Uniformed Patrol Division**

**89** separate physical arrests were made by Uniformed Patrol Division personnel during the **Year 2013** for drug related offenses.

#### **Warrant Arrests**

**440** arrests were made by Patrol Division personnel during the *Year 2013* on court-issued warrants.

#### **Criminal and SC Complaints**

**668** Criminal complaint summonses/warrants were signed by officers within the Patrol Division during the *Year 2013*.

#### **Directed Enforcement Details**

3,725 documented directed enforcement details were completed during the Year 2013.

#### **First Aid Calls**

**1,923** emergency first aid calls were answered by patrol officers during the *Year 2013*.

#### **Investigative Division**

The **Investigative Division** activities for the **Year 2013** are as follows:

#### **Case Management**

**198** cases were assigned during the **Year 2013** and currently **70** of the **198** remain open.

**128** of the **198** assigned cases were closed during the **Year 2013**.

#### **Off-hour Duty Calls**

**30** incidents required a detective to respond in during off hours during the **Year 2013**.

#### **Grand Jury Court Appearances**

**56** cases required the appearance of a detective at Grand Jury during the **Year 2013**.

#### **Drug Arrests by Detectives**

**37** separate physical arrests were made by Detective Bureau personnel during the *Year 2013* for drug related offenses.

#### **Prescription Drop Box**

In excess of **723** pounds of medication were collected in the Prescription Drop Box during the **Year 2013**.

#### **Background Investigations**

**Firearms - 699** firearms background investigations were conducted for **867** permits which were processed during the **Year 2013**.

Employment - 8 background investigations were conducted during the Year 2013.

**Volunteer Fire/First Aid - 18** volunteer background investigations were processed during **Year 2013**.

Solicitor - 16 solicitor permit backgrounds were processed during Year 2013.

#### **Property & Evidence**

The **Property & Evidence Function** activities for **Year 2013** are as follows:

- **1,401** pieces of **Stolen Property** were entered into the property module during the **Year 2013**.
- **200** pieces of **Lost Property** were entered into the property module during the **Year 2013**.
- **419** pieces of **Found Property** were entered into the property module during the **Year 2013** (includes recovered items and items held for safekeeping).
- **221 Impounded Vehicles** were entered into the property module during the *Year 2013*. [The excessive number is due to an administrative backlog of entries which is now updated and complete for 2013]
- 1,450 Articles of Evidence were entered into the property module during the Year 2013.
- **120 Firearm/Weapon** items were entered into the property module during the **Year 2013**.
- **91 Firearms/Weapons** were delivered to the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office Gun Unit during the *Year 2013*.
